Annual Dues and assessments (if any) are due by Sept. 1 each year and are subject to change by membership vote. New members that are accepted in JUNE, JULY and AUGUST are credited for the next year's dues. Junior memberships (12-18 yrs.) and Associate memberships (spouses) are half the regular dues. Junior and Associate members have no voting rights, and range use is limited to strict supervision by sponsoring adult member. MPRA is an official NRA recruiter and can process your NRA membership.

Procedures for MPRA Membership Applications:

1. Applicants must personally present a completed application form (originals only) and pay application fee, one year's dues, assessment fee (if any) and key charges during a regular membership meeting of MPRA. Meetings begin at 8:00pm on the second Thursday of each month at the range, located at 526 Van Duzer Road in the Town of Wallkill, NY. Applicants may solicit the two required MPRA member endorsements at any meeting.
 2. After presentation of a completed form, the MPRA Executive Committee will mail reference questionnaires to the applicant's three references listed on the application. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE APPLICANT TO HAVE HIS and HER REFERENCES RESPOND COMPLETELY AND TIMELY. Upon return of **all three** reference forms, completed and signed, the MPRA Membership Chairman will notify the applicant that his/her application will be presented to the general membership at the next meeting of the association. APPLICANTS MUST ALSO ATTEND THIS MEETING. The Membership Chairman will place the recommendations of the Executive Committee and its comments before the membership for a vote of confidence. During the presentation period for prospective members, the applicant shall receive a range orientation by the MPRA Chief Instructor, Executive Officer or their appointee. Upon majority vote of the attending membership, in support of a positive Executive Committee, the applicant shall be accepted to the conditional membership of the association.
 3. Upon completion of the range orientation, the applicant shall be informed of the membership's actions. If voted to conditional membership, the conditional member shall be issued a conditional membership card and welcomed to the MPRA membership. If an applicant is denied membership, all of the applicant's payments shall be returned to him or her.
- Conditional member **MUST** participate in and least **TWO** (2) MPRA scheduled target shooting events to gain regular membership and be issued a range key. If a conditional member can demonstrate prior competitive target shooting experience and familiarity with competition protocols, to the NRA standards, or alternatively, a prospective member can attend two range sessions conducted by certified club instructor. At each required event, the conditional member must log in using the range journal and have a regular member endorse the participation, recording this upon the back of the conditional member's card with the member's initials, date, event, and in a similar manner, alongside the conditional member's log in journal. When the two event requirements are completed, the conditional member is to notify the membership chairman, turn in the endorsement card, and be issued a regular membership card and a personal range key. A letter of acceptance will be mailed to the new member, along with a copy of the current MPRA calendar of events, MPRA bylaws and other information.
